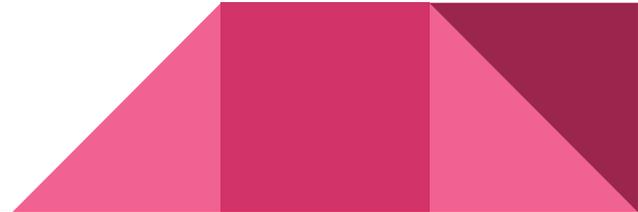

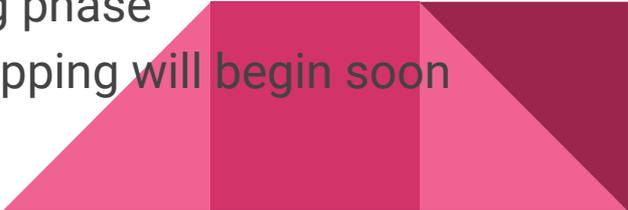

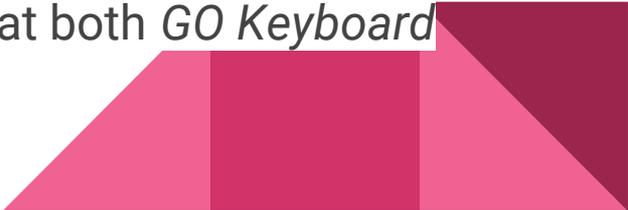

GO Keyboard(from google play store)

- The keyboard is developed by Chinese firm “GOMO”.
 - 200 million installations around the world.
 - According to Aduard security researchers, the applications were designed to siphon a large amount of user data, including Google account emails, device language, IMSI, location, network type, screen size, Android version and build, and device model.
 - Once App gets installed in Users Mobile, App Download an Executable code from Remote Server.
 - The security researchers have reported their findings to Google but it appears that the company hasn't taken a decision yet and that both *GO Keyboard* versions continue to be available in Google Play.
